The fastest and easiest way to start saving energy is to change the light bulbs in your current fixtures to compact fluorescent bulbs (CFLs). If you are remodeling, building a new home, or just updating the look of a room, consider installing new ENERGY STAR-qualified light fixtures.

The “Change The World, Start with ENERGY STAR” Campaign begins September 1, 2009 and runs through November 30, 2009. As part of this campaign you can receive an in-store instant rebate of fifty cents per spiral bulb purchased.

CFLs provide the same light as standard (incandescent) lighting, but use 75 percent less electricity! They produce less heat and have a longer lifespan. Yes, the initial cost is more, but you'll see savings because they cost less to operate and last up to ten times longer. And can a price be put on clean air and water for future generations?
