Summary of Proposed Rule

The Long Island Power Authority (the "Authority") is considering modifications to its Tariff for Electric Service ("Tariff") to effectuate the outcome of the Public Service Commission's Proceeding In the Matter of Energy Storage Deployment Program, Case No. 18-E-0130 (the "PSC Energy Storage Proceeding").¹

On June 21, 2018, the Public Service Commission published the New York State Energy Storage Roadmap (the "Roadmap") and established the PSC Energy Storage Proceeding for consideration of the recommendations in the Roadmap and receipt of feedback from stakeholders.

The PSC Energy Storage Proceeding is open to all interested stakeholders. The PSC has invited written feedback, analytical findings, and any other items that stakeholders feel should be considered as the Public Service Commission establishes a 2030 storage target and deployment mechanisms. When public comment hearings on topics related to the Energy Storage Proceeding are scheduled by the DPS, notice of the hearings will be posted on the DPS' Document and Matter Management System.² Additional public comment hearings will be held by the Authority in Nassau and Suffolk Counties. The dates and locations of the Authority's hearings will be posted on the Authority's website as they are scheduled.

Orders issued by the PSC pursuant to the process described above will be presented, together with a compendium of public comments received by the Authority, for consideration and adoption by the LIPA Board of Trustees at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board following issuance of the PSC order and the Authority's public comment hearings.³
