

## **RFI Natural Gas and Electricity Prepayment Suppliers**

Questions (due 9/18/19) and **Answers** (due 9/24/19)

1. Please provide LIPA's monthly gas usage for the past 5-years

**Answer: The Authority currently uses between 35,000 – 500,000 MMBtus per day of natural gas and supplies between 1400 – 5300 MWs per hour of electricity to its customers. As with most electric utilities, there can be daily variability due to customer consumption, weather, availability of generation, transmission capability and fuel prices. The Authority is considering gas prepayments for up to roughly 40,000 MMBtu per day or electricity prepayments for up to 500 MW per hour in its initial prepayment transaction(s).**

- a. Please provide volume allocated to each generation facility
- b. Volumes taken at National Grid / KEDLI city gate for Transco Zone 6 NY
- c. Volumes taken at Iroquois Zone 2

2. Please provide past history of power purchases at NYISO Zone K
