The Enterprise Resource Planning (“ERP”) Application Developer will perform application development and support functions in the development, implementation, modification and support of Human Resources, Finance and Procurement (HRFMS) applications, reports, forms, and interfaces. The ERP Application Developer will use Microsoft Dynamics 365 Finance & Operations to provide an integrated information system solution to meet the business needs of the Authority.

This position will design, develop and deploy Microsoft Dynamics 365 including entities, financials, operations, forms, workflows, reports and dashboards. The ERP Application Developer will also be responsible for providing technical expertise in Enterprise Resource Planning, Time and Attendance Systems and critical production support issue resolution.

The ERP Application Developer serves as the primary point of contact with the Finance, Human Resources and Procurement departments and must be able to work with functional and technical staff to understand their business functions as they relate to areas such as accounting, revenue, budget, disbursement, Procurement and HR Management, and also produce the requested documentation and provide project support, as needed .
