- Analysis that includes both top-down and bottom-up risk perspectives;
- Ability to perform deep dive analysis, such as developing bowties;
- Capability to identify cross-functional risk across the organization;
- Act as a repository of information for current and historical risk information;
- Provide notification of changes in real time and year-over-year as information is modified;
- Provide notification to subject matter users when items are due for input, review, and update;
- Provide risk dashboards and varying levels of detailed reports that can be used for departments, risk management committees, and the board of trustees;
- Capability to link risks to audits and strategic objectives; and
- Capability to link risk drivers to highlight interconnectivities.
