- CGI has been unable to find the root cause of the failure of the Jan. 12, 2023 performance smoke test conducted by LIPA
- PSEG Long Island is recommending that a new IV&V-specific test infrastructure be set up
 where the system/data from the Jan. 12th backup will be restored for reproducing the failure
 in order to investigate the root cause.
- LIPA will run a formal performance test once the root cause of the Jan. 12th failure has been addressed.
