What You'll Do At LIPA

The Vice President of Power Supply is responsible for fulfilling LIPA's mission of enabling clean, reliable, and affordable electric service for our customers through the operational and contractual oversight of LIPA's Service Providers and the setting of wholesale market policy.

The Vice President of Power Supply's responsibilities include managing the execution of a systematic and proactive approach to oversight of the services provided by LIPA's Service Providers, PSEG Long Island Power Markets department and PSEG Energy Resources and Trade ("PSEG ER&T"), such as:

- the Service Providers' performance within Contract Standards.
- the evaluation of on-going and proposed new programs and initiatives, management and administration of the power supply portfolio, proposed power supply contracts and other major decisions, including their consistency with the Board's policies, and analytical support of LIPA's participation in wholesale markets and regulatory processes.
- the monitoring of progress in accordance with approved plans and goals.
- overseeing the operations conducted by PSEG ER&T to ensure cost-effective procurement of fuel and purchases and sales of power.

Other Essential Job Functions include:

- ❖ Managing the Power Supply Department, including:
 - managing staff and consultant performance and productivity.
 - reviewing and executing the Power Supply Department's work plans each year.
 - continuously refining systems and procedures to improve the department's performance and document staff's oversight work product.
- ❖ Contributing to LIPA's conduct of wholesale markets policy and fuel and power procurement, including:
 - advocacy at Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, New York Independent System Operator, and New York Public Service Commission on behalf of Long Island customers.
 - acquisition and contract negotiation for clean energy and power supply resources.
 - oversight of operations conducted by PSEG ER&T, including negotiating appropriate changes to ER&T's performance metrics, to ensure cost effective procurement of fuel and purchases and sales of power.
- ❖ Contributing to LIPA's strategic vision, including:
 - the vision for reliability and affordability.
 - the long-term strategy for cost-effective clean energy and power supply resource acquisition, including integrated resource planning and related studies.
 - advising the Board on policies related to power supply.
 - implementing appropriate changes to PSEG Long Island's annual performance metrics and budgets necessary to translate the strategic vision into action.
- ❖ Educating the Board of Trustees on utility industry trends, operations and common industry practices and preparing useful and understandable reports to the Trustees on relevant Board policies and topics.
