The ideal candidate will possess a strong background in project management, excellent communication skills, and a proven ability to deliver IT projects on time and within budget. The position involves planning, executing, and completing projects according to deadlines and budget constraints, including resource acquisition and coordination of team members and third-party contractors. The IT Project Manager will define project objectives, oversee quality control throughout the project lifecycle, and work closely with various departments to meet all project requirements, deadlines, and schedules. Effective communication with stakeholders at all levels is required to align projects with business goals and objectives while simultaneously managing multiple projects of varying complexity.

- Develops and implements quality control processes to ensure project deliverables meet standards and expectations. Conducts testing and quality assurance activities as necessary
- Monitors project expenditures, ensuring adherence to the budget. Identifies cost-saving opportunities and manages project finances effectively
- Assesses the impact of project changes and manages change requests. Develops and executes change management plans to minimize disruptions
- Maintains comprehensive project documentation, including project plans, status reports and documentation of project decisions
- Generates regular reports for stakeholders and management
- Conducts post-project evaluations to assess the project's success and identify areas for improvement
- Captures lessons learned for future projects.
- Ensures that IT projects comply with relevant regulations, standards, and security requirements
- Implements security measures and best practices to protect data and systems
- Collaborates with third-party vendors and contractors when necessary, managing their performance and deliverables
