

Description of Implementing Actions

In addition to the adoption of the proposed LIPA PPTN Formula Rate, LIPA will be taking other actions necessary to implement the recovery of LIPA costs of transmission facilities and network upgrades constructed and operated by LIPA as a Designated Entity in the Public Policy Transmission Planning process, including:

- (1) Cooperation with the NYISO in the filing and establishment of a tariff sheet in Rate Schedule 10 of the NYISO Open Access Transmission Tariff that will incorporate, as a stated rate, the ATRR calculated pursuant to the LIPA PPTN Formula Rate as well as confirmation that the designated cost allocation methodology for LIPA-incurred costs for the construction, operation and ownership of transmission facilities and network upgrades implementing the selected Long Island Offshore PPTN Project will be a load ratio share allocation, *which is calculated volumetrically based on actual energy withdrawals by all Load Serving Entities serving load in the New York Control Area*, consistent with the recommendation of the NY PSC¹ and the cost allocation methodology adopted by all other Designated Entities for the Long Island Offshore PPTN Project.²

- (2) Establishment of dedicated page on the LIPA website (www.lipower.org) for the LIPA PPTN Formula Rate that will include: (i) posting of the formula rate and implementing protocols; (ii) a list of transmission facilities and network upgrades for which LIPA has been identified as a Designated Entity and the associated Public Policy Transmission Needs Project requiring the construction and operation of such elements; (iii) the effective ATRR, including supporting worksheets produced in the calculation of the Rate Year ATRR; (iv) a calendar reporting the windows and deadlines for the public information and review process under Section II.3 of the implementing protocols; and (v) contact information for public inquiries.
