This role is pivotal in supporting the financial planning and management of technology projects within our organization. The IT Budget Analyst reports to the Manager of IT Performance and Procurement and assists in reviewing monthly metrics and ensuring key performance indicators are met.

Analysis of IT Project Budget Proposals:

- ❖ Evaluate and analyze budget proposals for IT projects
- ❖ Forecast project expenses considering the project schedule and identified risks
- ❖ Provide accurate and timely financial projections to support decision-making
- ❖ Monitor and track the progress of technology projects against the approved budget
- ❖ Ensure expenditures are recorded accurately and remain within budgetary projections
